

Decent guide, really like that it shows "normal" exams, allowing for comparison with my patient's films. On occasion I wish for a few more views, as what the guide has and what the tech provides are different, but overall it is a great help when I need clarification and can't get a hold of the radiologist.

I bought this because there doesn't seem to be any smaller books on the market that are just made for radiographic anatomy. Our exams include radiographic critique and many times we are asked to identify anatomy that hasn't been identified in our regular book. I thought this would be a great supplemental book. It does include a large variety of exam types, and I like that there's a drawing of the exact radiographs with anatomy pointed out rather than lines or arrows on the actual radiograph. The quality of the radiographs is pretty awful. Many of them are full of noise (fog) and/or underexposed. Makes it hard to see anatomy when it's not a high quality diagnostic image.
