


The book was found

Lucia Whitney was born and raised in San Francisco to parents of Sicilian descent. She worked at San Francisco State University as a librarian for many years and has a background in theater arts. Her love of art, travel, and different cultures brought her to many places throughout the world, and her book, Tomorrow the Mudmen, is a memoir of her profound adventure to Papua New Guinea. Whitney currently lives in Belvedere, California, and continues to travel regularly.

A delightful account of a trip taken by the author in the late seventies to a remote and primitive area of New Guinea which at the time was rarely (if ever) visited by Westerners. She describes herself as a "novice explorer" but she is hardly a novice about her very insightful observations of the art, culture and people of this fascinating land. Even though this is her first trip to the area she immerses herself into all facets of this adventure and takes the reader along with her. Especially noteworthy is her great attachment to many of the tribes people she meets which is facilitated by her learning the language to communicate with them (no small feat.) Her ability to relate to the people she encounters is underscored by the great gift - a branch of oleander - given to her by an important

chief of one of the villages she visited and the tearful goodbyes when the trip ends from two young people she befriended. This is a page turner from beginning to end. Anyone with a sense of adventure and a desire to learn more about the people of Papua New Guinea will love this book.
