

I really liked this little book. I was able to make perfect bracelets, beads and all, first try, having never used "knots" before. The diagrams and instructions were clear and the pictures showed design details. Possibly heavier twine was used for the models in order to photograph better as my results were very fine, as in dainty, using the 1 mm cord suggested, and I much preferred this. Yes, the book is basic but I probably wouldn't have felt I could attempt it otherwise! And I soon automatically used shortcuts, like rolling the string ends into bobbins and shortening the filler cords

where possible to lessen waste. I did make my fastening loop smaller than suggested, maybe 3/8" total, which gave a more secure closure. And I don't think this is "kid stuff". The only odd thing: in several places I read "slide the bead through the cords" - obviously you slide the cords through the beads!

I found this guide very helpful and easy to follow. The first part of the guide shows step by step examples of how to make string bracelets by tying various knots (half knot, half hitch, square knot, open square knot, butterfly knot, switch knot, alternate double half hitch). The extras section provided several methods for adding beads to the bracelets. The second part of the guide covers necklaces, braided jewelry, and on-line resources for string and beads. The guide's instructions are clear, each step includes an illustrated drawing which shows exactly how to place the strings. The author included many nice photos of the completed bracelet so you have an idea of what you will get at the end. Anyone can make bracelets, however it will take some practice to make them as nice as even as the author's bracelets! I was looking for a project that would be fun to do with a group of youngsters (boys and girls) and making string bracelets was a big hit! Everyone enjoyed tying knots and exchanging bracelets at the end. I could not have done it without this little guide! Ali Julia review

This was actually fairly helpful - good step by step illustrations, including the all important closure. Great start for making simple stackable arm candy - just head to the local craft store to pick up some twine and perhaps a few beads, and you're ready to go! There's also a decent explanation of twine/cord basics for someone just starting out.

I got this book free and had low expectations, but it's actually nice thorough intro to cord jewelry, also with the basics on adding beads. I have never made string/ cord jewelry before and I feel like this book contains plenty of info for me to make some projects with my kids.

The directions are so helpfull love love it the reference is right on. I love to actually have the explanation and the picture is great I have been macrameing my heart out brings me back to the seventies I am 60yrs. old retired live in a log cabin in alaska keeps me busy.

I used this to help me make several little projects. I don't think her measurements work out all the time but the method is easy to follow. For me, I learned by doing and from my own mistakes. Isabella does a great job photographing the finished projects so you see how it should turn out. It's

clear and easy to understand. I have enjoyed making the bracelets and look forward to applying her steps to other projects as well.

I bought this to help plan easy projects for children and it looks as though it will meet my needs. I'm making a bracelet now and the directions are easy to follow.
