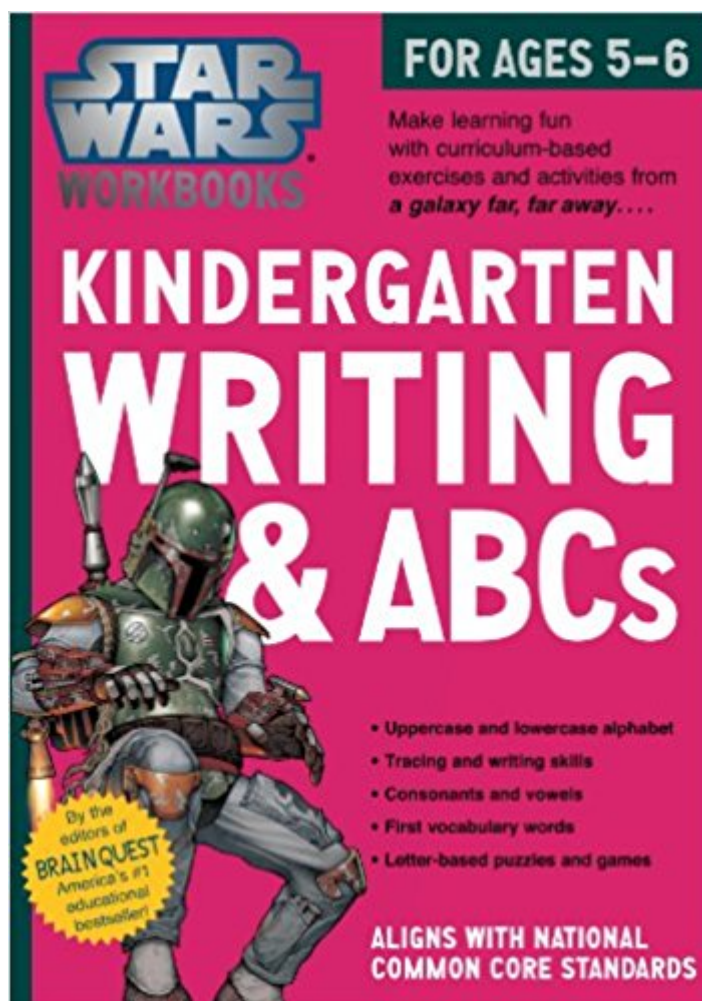

And Language Arts—Circle the correct homophone in this sentence: Luke is a Jedi knight/night. Featuring favorite characters like Luke Skywalker, Queen Amidala, Yoda, and Obi-Wan Kenobi, and other creatures, monsters, Jedi, and Sith, the workbooks are filled with thousands of original illustrations drawing from all six Star Wars movies and the expanded Star Wars universe. WOW! This book is so awesome. I've been working with my four year old at home on writing and he has not wanted to do his "homework" at all. This book really has barely anything to do with Star Wars besides a picture on each page but yet he loves it! I save this for the end of his lesson and it motivates him to work hard in order to get to do his Star Wars book. Such a simple concept but man does it excite him!

I ordered this for my soon to be 3rd Grader who's writing has steadily gotten worse each year. He loves Star Wars so I hoped this would help with his fundamental writing skills. He loved looking at the book, but not quite as excited about actually working in the book. So far it is at least showing him the correct way to form his letters. Will update after we complete the book.

Gave this to my preschooler for summer work prior to entering Kindergarten. This workbook pushed him to learn the ABCs and to write them. My son struggles with the writing part but this book is very clear about how to write out each letter. Also I love the coloring activities. He loves to color and using the ABCs as coloring criteria is very useful and engaging. And of course the Star Wars theme is a huge hit. Well done.

My 6 year old loves this workbook. The cartoon pictures are adorable and each letter has a theme. He's on a 2nd grade reading level, but his handwriting is the worst in the kinder class. I'm hoping

this book will improve his handwriting skills. He reads the sentence for each letter and then traces the upper case and lower case. Then he traces and reads the words on the second page. Every letter also gets a fun activity page.

Love these books! We homeschool and they're wonderful supplemental tool. They keep my children interested in learning.

My 5 year old will be starting Kindergarten soon so got this and the Math Skills one for the summer. He seems to like it a lot as he finished it in 1.5 weeks. It keeps him interested and not too much coloring (he hates coloring). Would recommend it.

I have purchased several of these Star Wars workbooks for my 6 year old. He absolutely loves working in them, and they truly offer a fun learning experience. These books are wonderful teaching tools and have dozens of different types of activities in them, so your child will not get bored from repetitiveness.

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
