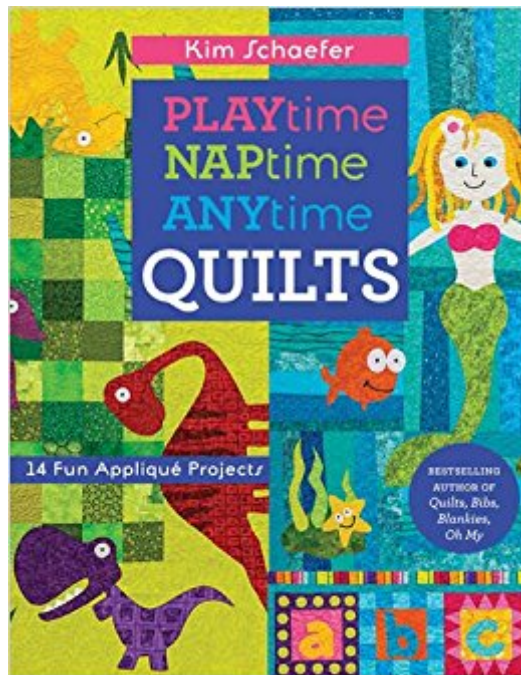

The author of *Quilts, Bibs, Blankies...Oh My!* presents another book full of must-make quilts for children. The little ones will love to have a dinosaur stomping across their quilt, or a rocket taking off, and girls will adore the Little Miss Mermaid design. Not all projects are quilts. There are instructions to make placemats and a small naptime mat and a drum set. There is also a wonderful colourful cuddle blanket made from minky. Full-size templates are provided in pull-out pages, making them quick to find and re-use. Plus you could easily adapt the appliqué designs for other uses, such as pillowcases. There is bound to be at least one project that is perfect for a young person you know. (Down Under Quilts, Issue 176) Any moms who quilt are bound to find something adorable in this book for a child. Kim's appliqué designs are delightful. Included are full-size patterns for quilts, wall hangings, growth charts, nap mats, placemats, floor cushions and t-shirts. I particularly love the placemats. Very disappointing. The patterns are on a 38" by 25 1/2" paper. The sizes at the copy place are 24" x 36" and 36" x 48". The paper is printed front and back with several animals outlined over other animals on each side. To make the giraffe it would take four copies to have individual pattern pieces. The Tiger is on the giraffe, the monkey, and the lion, and it goes on like that for each of the animal, leaves, etc. Positioned correctly you could have the printer use 36 by 24 inch blueprint paper, but at \$3.39 a copy, times what you need to have pattern pieces for the entire quilt, That is a min. of 12 copies. That is over \$40. more before you even buy the fabric, batting, etc.Â Playtime, Naptime, Anytime Quilts: 14 Fun AppliquÃ© Projects

LOTS of cute ideas in this book, however I am VERY disappointed in the way the patterns are printed. Pieces from more than one quilt are on one page and printed over pieces from a different quilt. Pattern pieces are stacked and printed on top of each other making it difficult to find the pieces needed. Found one piece which was not numbered in the rocket quilt pattern. There is a major error in the castle quilt pattern which I did not notice until fabric was cut, & heat and bond was ironed on. The path pattern was not reversed so it would lay the direction shown on finished quilt. I had to decide whether to go back to store to buy another 1/2 yard of fabric to replace it, or use it with path going wrong direction.No pattern piece to cut out shape of hill on castle quilt. At least I did not find the pattern. Given that pieces for the castle quilt were printed on more than one section (group) of pieces, I may just not have been able to find it, but no pattern for the hill was to be found.Directions for making quilt are very vague.Would I buy this book again? Would I recommend this book to others? Given the way the pieces are printed out, absolutely not! Though the projects in the book are VERY cute, the patterns are a huge mess!
