

This was more of an advertisement for all his other books. Searcy gives an outline for his 8 systems but there is very little else. It functions as a teaser for the rest of his works

A good jumping in point if you need to start the process of analyzing your church systems; also leads you to next steps.

Once again we see a business model applied to the church. The church is not a business. Systemic thinking is important. One is better served by applying systems theory from marriage & family therapy to the church than a business model.

If you're looking to find help for your church this book will break your church into eighth basic areas and provide ways you can improve each one or all eight.

I love the fact that this book doesn't focus on one style of church, or the other. Just like a car churches come in all shapes and sizes, but what is under the hood is very similar in all models. If the systems are healthy the church will be healthy. I would recommend this book to all pastors, elders, and other church leaders.
