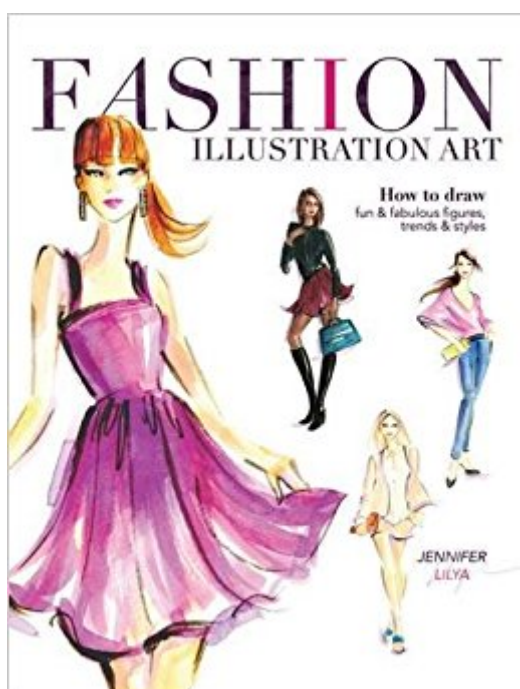


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# Fashion Illustration Art: How To Draw Fun & Fabulous Figures, Trends And Styles
