Years of casual encounters and heated play sessions with seasoned submissives have left him numb and the older he gets, the more the lifestyle loses its allure. The change he knows he needs isn't easy to come by. But change is closer than he thinks. Beneath blinding strobe lights toils an omega eager for a better future. Lucian Bracknell is finally free from the horrors of The White Lotus brothel, and for the first time in his life, he's on his own. Independence means discovering who he is and redefining his relationship with the world, but when he lands a bartending job at The Shepherd, that world turns upside down. Behind The Shepherd's bar counter, Lucian is untouchable, and a drug he can't get enough of. Until his eyes lock with those of an alpha he's not allowed to have, and those firm a's turn to whimpered a's. But forbidden desire this hot can't be contained forever, and when the fires of their lust start to scorch, Marcus and Lucian will either have to succumb to the heat and face the consequences together, or burn with it until one of them falls on their knees and begs for relief. Beg is a 60,000 word BDSM-flavored novel set following the events of Obey. While best enjoyed as a sequel, it's packed full of enough sexting, bourbon, and rope burn to be enjoyed on its own.

This was probably my least favorite of the books in this series. I didn't really feel like Lucian was the same character that we had met previously. I also wonder how Lucian and Marcus could be together for six months, Marcus is in the wedding party, and yet, they had never met, as a couple, with Crawford and Owen prior to the wedding itself. The story was more enjoyable as a stand alone, in my opinion. Lucian's submission to Marcus was beautiful to read, and I loved that Lucian struggled with what it meant for him to give up his control to Marcus.

I loved this addition to the M/M Omegaverse series by Piper Scott. Marcus and Lucian are perfect together and have excellent chemistry. I liked how independent Lucian has become and how he has embraced the ability to say no. I also liked Marcus and how he works around the rules of the club and their anti fraternization rules between patrons and employees. I can't wait to read the next book in the series. I voluntarily reviewed an advanced reader copy of this book.

I don't usually read alpha/omega books, but this was an extremely satisfying story. Well-written, with excellent characters and a wonderful plot. And hot love scenes!

This book is a sequel to Obey, but features a different couple and can stand on its own. Before Obey, I'd never run across the idea of BDSM *with* Alpha/omega dynamics, but I loved it. And much as I loved it, I think I loved this one even MORE. Lucian and Marcus were both complex, interesting characters. Because it was written in dual POV, you really understood Marcus' boredom with the same scene he's been around for years, and why Lucian is such a breath of fresh air (that's forbidden, since he WORKS at the kink club, and isn't a member). You also understand Lucian's hesitation to give up his freedom to an alpha after bad experiences in the past. Their relationship progresses in a natural, believable way, over the course of weeks of encounters, with a few (also believable) setbacks. The BDSM aspects were explained SO WELL in this book - not just what was physically happening, but the reasoning behind it. There were moments that a big lightbulb flashed

over my head and made me go "OH!!!!" Like this one:~ Every freedom of yours that I take away, I take into myself.~ Marcus kept his voice above a whisper, but still low enough that the statements were intimate. [. . .] ~ When I limit you, I take the responsibility of your care onto my shoulders. Everything I do, I do to set you free of the limits you~ve imposed upon yourself.~ Suddenly, cuffs and blindfolds and such make so much more sense to me. And seeing the care and affection lavished on Lucian after a scene made me realize it wasn't just a power trip, as borne out by this moment:He rubbed a thumb across Lucian's cheek. ~ I am devoted to your pleasure. I never want you to forget that.~ As an aside, the writing in this book is just amazing. Somehow, the author takes something as mundane as ice cubes dropping into a glass and turns it into something beautiful.I was really happy with how this ended. It gave the reader a glimpse into their future, without having to unrealistically rush things.Can't wait for the next in the series!!!!

Beg is the book I didn't even know I was waiting for. Piper Scott is a new author to me and I had just stumbled across Obey as a recommendation from some friends and I really enjoyed it so when I found out a longer release was literally a day away, I was excited.I am new to this whole omega verse thing. Alphas and omegas, while not entirely foreign to me, aren't a subset that I've done a lot of reading in. The idea of characters who embody shifter traits without shifting is somewhat appealing and I think these 2 stories are a great introduction.That aspect aside, I cannot think of an MM novel that I've read that approaches BDSM as accurately, appropriately and enjoyable as Beg. I have had discussions with a group of reader friends about BDSM, and especially D/s and why submission isn't demeaning and this book takes everything I was trying to share with them and puts it on the page perfectly.I liked Lucian. I think he's a brave and smart character, and I liked his introduction in Obey. Marcus though... Marcus is in a class of his own as far as I'm concerned. He is handsome, and suave and oh so dominant. He shows the utmost affection and concern for Lucian and proves himself to be the perfect Dom and the perfect partner.I would love to see more of them, because their chemistry leaps off the page. This book was so hard for me to put down, and I have no doubt I'll be revisiting it in the future.

Omega Lucian released from slavery in a brothel and just finished his rehabilitation is determined to make the most of his life now he is his own man. He gets a job as a bartender in a kink club and feel it is a step forward to a brighter future. Marcus-An Alpha finding the casual hookups no longer fulfill his needs is bored and finding it hard to be interested until he looks at the club's new bartender.
