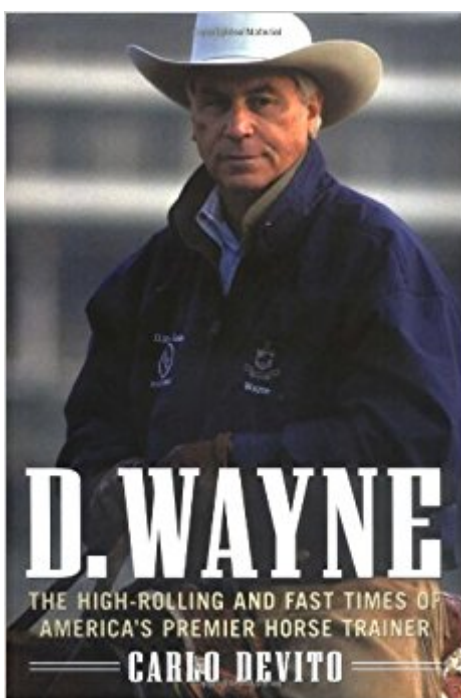


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D. Wayne: The High-Rolling And Fast Times Of America's Premier Horse Trainer
