

I have been teaching English as a second language for more than 20 years. I am also a technical writer. Over the years I have watched people lose their command of the English language. All of this is probably due to the digital age where communication is reduced to a bare minimum. It is to this generation, that does not have the patience to analyze a text, let alone work through the convoluted style of writing used in the 1700s that Maranzenboim's book is directed. Nevertheless, anyone who appreciates the importance of Josephus to our understanding of history from the first century, particularly of the Jewish people and Rome's interactions with them, will find this book a bargain! Maranzenboim is the first person in decades to take this challenging text and turn it into something truly readable and comprehensible. It includes a brilliant color timeline, original artwork, and a true summarization and simplification of the original translation into English of *The History of the Jews* by Josephus. I can think of a lot of uses for this book: home schooled students studying the history of the Jewish people; Bar/Bat Mitzvah students, amateur historians, and more. Some people may think this book is an oversimplification, but in an age where people just don't have the patience to read difficult text, I would suggest that this book should be the first step towards getting into the deeper stuff. For many, this book will be enough, and you won't be sorry. Instead of hearing about what Josephus wrote, you'll be able to say, I read Josephus! Happy reading!

In *Josephus: The History of the Jews Condensed in Simple English*, Miriam Maranzenboim does a great favor to anyone interested in the historical period from the time of Jesus and the destruction of the Second Temple. Many of us have heard fascinating quotes from Flavius Josephus, but when we actually picked up the book and tried to read it, we became quickly discouraged by its length and difficult language. Now for the first time, Maranzenboim opens up the possibility for everyone to

enjoy this fascinating and important book. As the author writes in her Introduction, she doesn't claim to be an historian but is good with words and loves history, and both qualities are immediately obvious to the reader. She even gives us a three page example in the beginning comparing her simplified translation and the original translation so that we can understand the work she did, clearly a labor of love.

I met Miriam at a conference this year and she told me about the book written to make Josephus more understandable. Well, I have tried to read the original Josephus several times and it was JUST TOO TEDIOUS to keep my attention - and the type was too small. I read the sample for Miriam's book and it is so much more readable. I am looking forward to reading Josephus at last. Good job Miriam!
