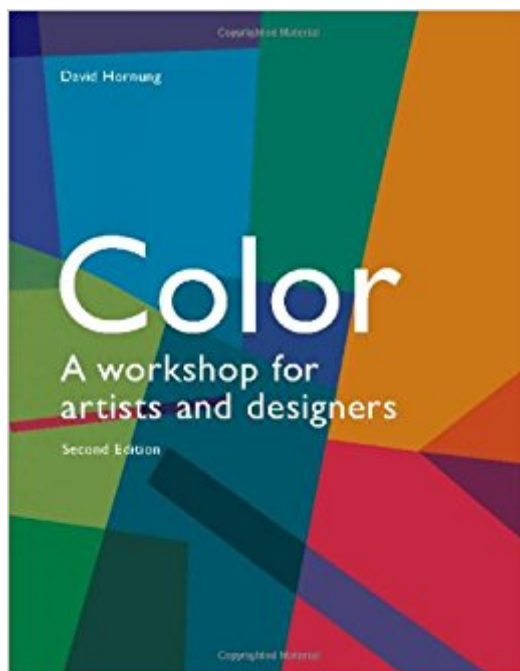

In two dense but clear chapters the author presents very complete color concepts. The remainder of the book shows exercises to clarify and cement the concepts. One comes away with a feeling of good understanding and of course the absolute delight of playing with color.

I have bought numerous books on color theory and this book is the best. It's not a scholarly epistle but very practical and shows great knowledge. I am about halfway through the series of exercises and have learned a great deal. I have been painting for many years and have new insight.

Hornung's writing on color theory is concise and easy to understand. This book includes an extensive collection of color theory exercises and material information--perfect for teaching yourself
