

Mike Hudson is founding editor of the Niagara Falls Reporter, a feisty independent weekly now entering its tenth year of publication. He is the author of DIARY OF A PUNK, about his youth as lead singer of legendary Cleveland punk band the Pagans, and MOB BOSS, the first full-length biography of Stefano Magaddino, who ruled the Buffalo mob from his fortress-like funeral parlor in Niagara Falls. A collection of Hudson's spoken word recordings was released in 1998 on the Overground label as ALL THE WRONG PEOPLE ARE DYING. Hudson's upcoming collection of fiction and nonfiction is titled JETSAM.

I've enjoyed Mike Hudson's books two of them: "Niagara Falls Confidential" and "Mob Boss". Living in Rochester, New York I've read many books by local historian Michael Keene, who, like Hudson, has an interest in the sexy, violent, and strange angles of history. Keene excels at writing about spiritualism (séances and such, which started in Rochester with the Fox sisters) the way Hudson excels at writing about mob life centering around the character of Don Stefano Magaddino (Niagara Falls gangster). Hudson's writing is something like good newspaper writing -- no frills but intelligently done.

I liked this book more than I thought I would. Each chapter abt a different occurrence, person or event. Easy to pick up and put down again. Stories of famous people from Niagara Falls, Mob events, crimes, murders, curses, and folklore and history. Very interesting read. 1 or 2 gruesome
