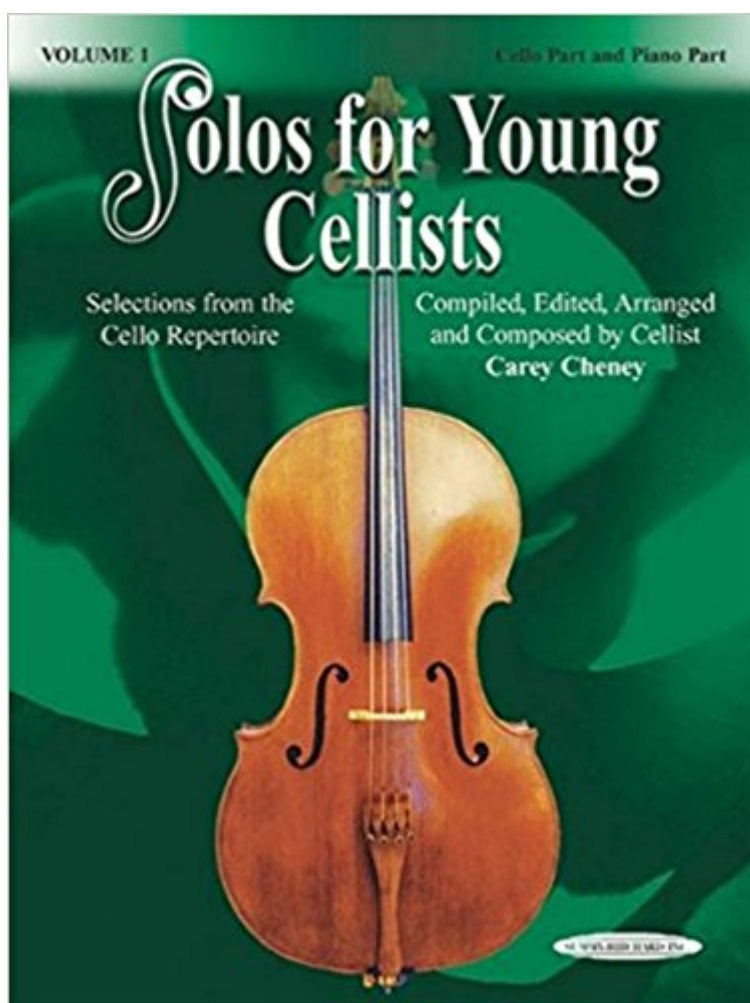

## Customer Reviews

This is a great book for cello players who have gotten past the beginning stage and are looking for a challenge. I would not recommend this to beginning cellists as the book starts at a pretty intermediate level, and it goes through a variety of keys and even hand positions. Instead, I use this as a supplement to Suzuki Vol. 1 and other printouts in situations where my students are highly motivated and looking to progress even further. Its a challenge, but especially rewarding if the

teacher is able to accompany with the included piano accompaniment. My students really get the feeling they are playing some solid, fun pieces, rather than just short pieces in Suzuki which may otherwise feel too technical.

Was unclear from the product description that this was the piano part. Sure, the violin music was also included, but it was not the principal violin book. Our violin instructor informed me that they are usually sold together. I am disappointed that I will now need to buy another book - the one I thought I was purchasing in the first place.

Recommended by my teacher - Very good book

I am an adult student of the cello with about one year of playing so far. My teacher recommended this book and so far I am thoroughly enjoying it. It is a great mix of workable yet challenging pieces that sound great and are fun to listen to.
