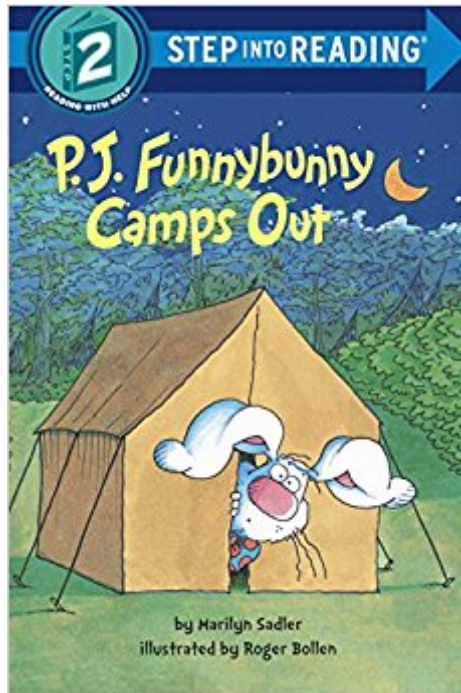

I bought a few of these as prize items for a camp-themed party. I wanted to like the theme (spoiler

alert) that a group of boys that tells one of their younger sisters that "girls can't camp" get their due and karma wins. And it's a little funny, but I wish it would have shown that the girls could out-camp the boys, rather than scare them and get the boys to run home. Then again, what do you expect from a story about an anthropomorphized group of a bunny, pig, raccoon and beaver going camping. In terms of being a reading level 2, that level seemed on target and this was a pretty easy read for my kindergartner.

We read this book to our grandkids before they camped out in our back yard this summer! P. J. Funnybunny is an awesome first reader for your child and our grands listened for every sound P.J. heard too!
