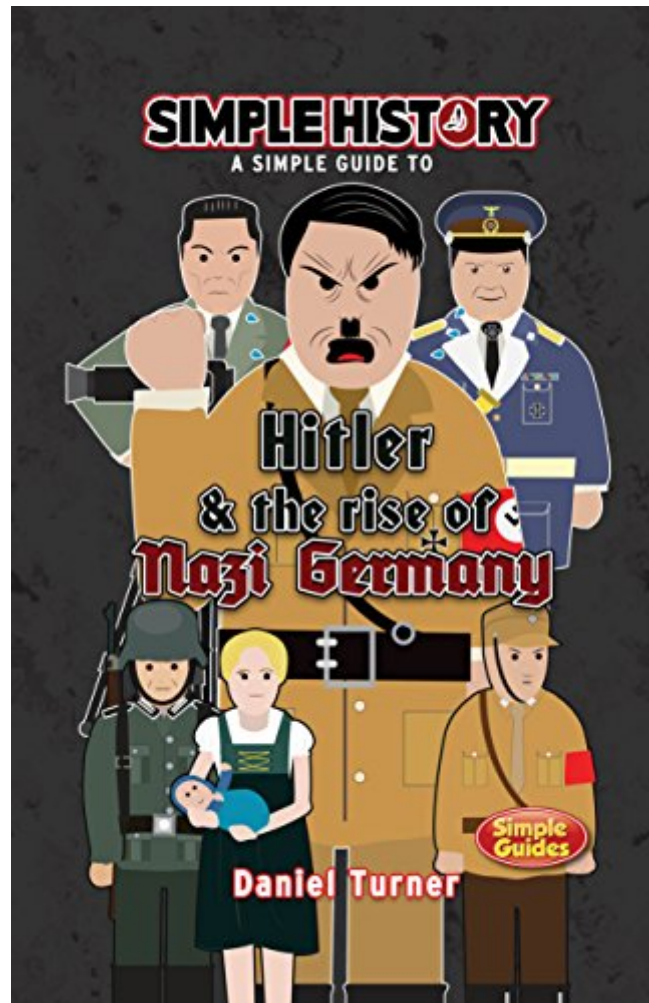

This book presents the important events in a very easy-to-understand format simplified by stylistic illustrations (which have similar feel to the animation style of South Park) that makes the assimilation of the information herein even more effective and very enjoyable. The book did a great job in pinpointing the salient events in that period of history, explaining them in terms that anyone can understand and in an exposition that is both fun and educational, and simplifying the chronology of events in a manner that is far from confusing.
