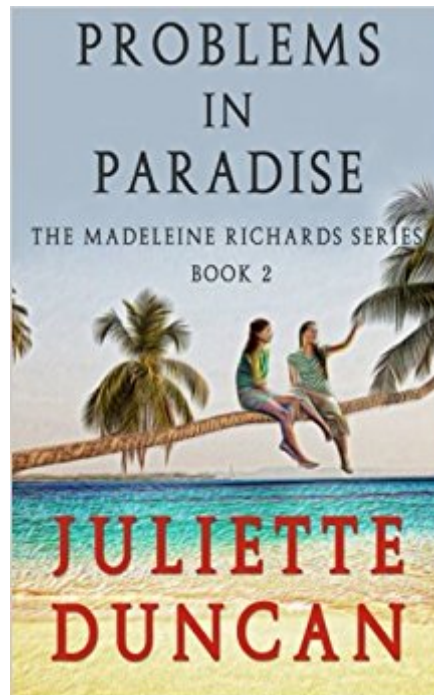




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Problems In Paradise (The Madeleine Richards Series) (Volume 2)

Book Two of the Madeleine Richards Series, "Problems in Paradise," has the feel of one of my old favorite tween series, Babysitters' Club only with Christian overtones. The episodic feel to the story-line was less noticeable in the first book of this series, but that is as it should be. From the first page, the characters are familiar, and it takes less time to warm up to the heroine. However, readers will be happy to find that, while Maddy has adjusted to the changes life has thrown at her, her adventurous spirit has not diminished. The next chapter in her life has her traveling to paradise. Against the lush, tropical setting of the island of Hawaii, and once again accompanied by her best friend, Hannah, Maddy's natural nosiness leads her into an adventure that puts her faith to the test. Her struggle with her understanding of faith is realistic and handled wisely by the author. Young readers love series and will definitely be looking forward to the next book.
