

After her husband retired, Betty felt the Lord calling her to minister to younger women. Betty and her husband divide their time between Michigan and Florida.

It's very frustrating to me when the writer asks a "yes" or "no" question and you are given three or four lines to write on then later asks an in-depth question and gives you half a line to answer. I found a mistake in the first chapter (but it's been too long and I don't remember specifics now) which then made me question everything after that. I have no patience with shoddy work and this would qualify. I love the idea that this book was built upon and we adapted it to fit our group but was overall disappointed.

My church has done 3 sessions of this program with these books, love it. We modified the content of each subject to fit our group, but this book is a good start/template.
