

Down The Highway: The Life Of Bob Dylan



Synopsis

Gossipy, for those who crave "intimate" looks at the lives of others. But the real failing with Sounes's work is his analysis of Dylan's songs. Given that lyrics, like poetry, are open to interpretation, but over and over Sounes gets the song's meanings dead-wrong. "*Down the Highway*" gave me the impression that the author was more interested in exposing Dylan as an imperfect man than a great artist. In any case, the best work I've read, to date, is Paul Williams's 3-volume "*Bob Dylan Performing Artist*," which presents an interpretation and background for Dylan's output through 2001. And, of course, there are other works of merit, as well.

Interesting read if you love Bob Dylan. Seems pretty accurate. I did enjoy reading this book.
