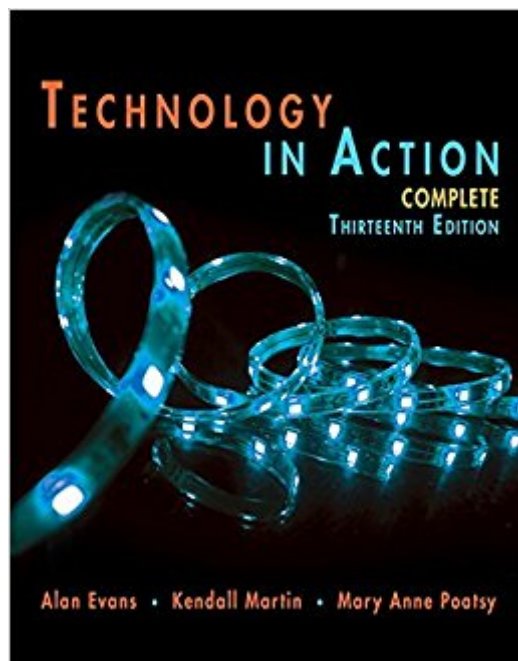




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Technology In Action Complete (13th Edition) (Evans, Martin & Poatsy, Technology In Action Series)
