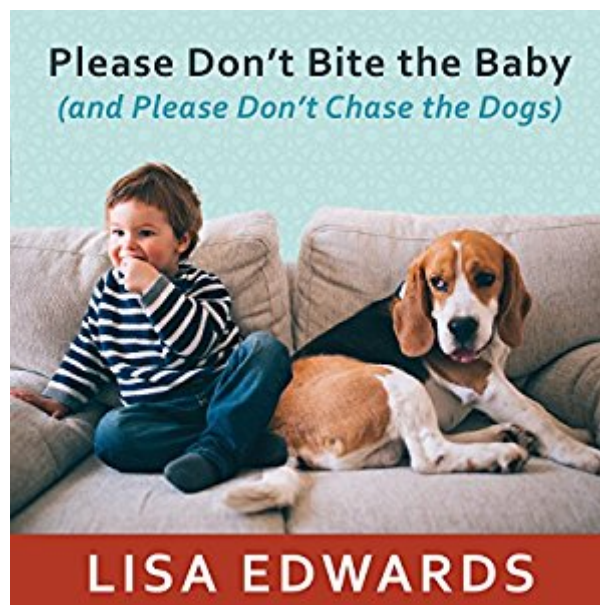

I really enjoyed this book. It's a mix of memoir and practical training advice (clearly differentiated by typeface so you can find the part you want). I know other reviewers didn't like this combo, but it really appealed to me. This showed the complexities of behavior and the grey areas that arise when trying to make the best decisions for two very loved family members- even as those family members have competing needs. The memoir aspects showed how the author wrestled with various things, from the exhaustion of the newborn phase to making decisions about a dog with a bite history. It offered very clear cautions about what can go wrong, and then explored how the author confronted those challenges. She was usually successful, but there were a few "learn from my mistakes moments" that I really appreciated. Meanwhile, the training portions were straight-forward and clear. I would DEFINITELY recommend this book to others. It's easy to read and far more informative than the other books I've read on the topic.
