This is a great introductory into science for your little ones. I got it for my 6-7 year old daughter. It covers a good scope of information. She LOVES science and wants to be some kind of scientist when she grows up. This workbook is great for getting acquainted with a variety of info and basics. I wouldn't use it as a sole science part of the curriculum, especially if you want to go deeper or have more science in your curriculum, but it's great for basics and as introductory to science. The pages on the book are thick and glossy like. I wasn't a huge fan of the pages being glossy, but I did like the

thickness of the pages a lot. It also comes with gold star stickers and a chart to place them on for each page you complete. We stick them on the page itself. Over all a great workbook for a great price. I recommend as a supplement to your curriculum!

We are using this inexpensive book (and others in the series) with our 1st grade homeschooled daughter. She enjoys the short lesson and loves getting a star on every page. I use the book as a starting point to teach from (along with other books and materials) to keep her somewhat in pace with other-schooled kids. This is not a stand-alone curricula but a lightweight review or introduction.

My 1st grader enjoys this workbook. She usually doesn't like doing workbook, but she looks forward to doing this one. It's a little too easy for the most part. There are some part that you have to just know it because what you read doesn't really help you answer the questions that are asked.

My daughter loved this workbook. It is, however, quite easy and she finished the entire workbook in three months. She loved putting the stickers on the lessons. A kindergartener could also easily do the lessons in this workbook.

Very nice, each page is a lesson, "a very short " lesson. It's a good review from Kindergarten but a little too basic as a 1st grade learning tool. We are using ours as review over the summer. Overall it is written nicely and the graphics are nice as well.

I know that this was for first grade, however, my first grader was highly disappointed with it. We did not enjoy it at all, very much a bummer. My daughter said that she knew a majority of the things in the book that we were going over just from watching our family. Maybe we do more with our children than most parents do, that's the reason for 3 stars and not 1. It may be a great book for some, but for us, it wasn't up to par.

I saw the reviews that said this workbook was way too easy, but my son is a late bloomer so I got his grade level. I'm honestly thinking I should save it until my daughter turns 4. It's painfully simple for my son. Gave 3 stars because I think it would be fun for little kids and the price is awesome.
