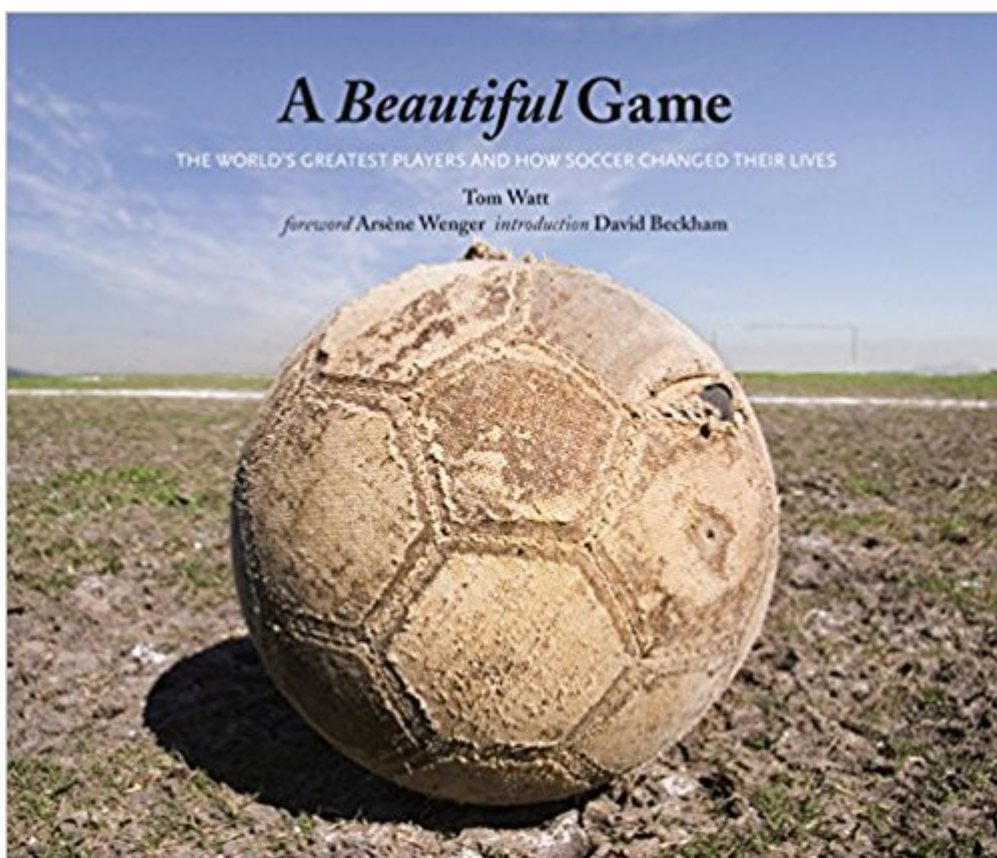




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A Beautiful Game: The World's Greatest Players And How Soccer Changed Their Lives
