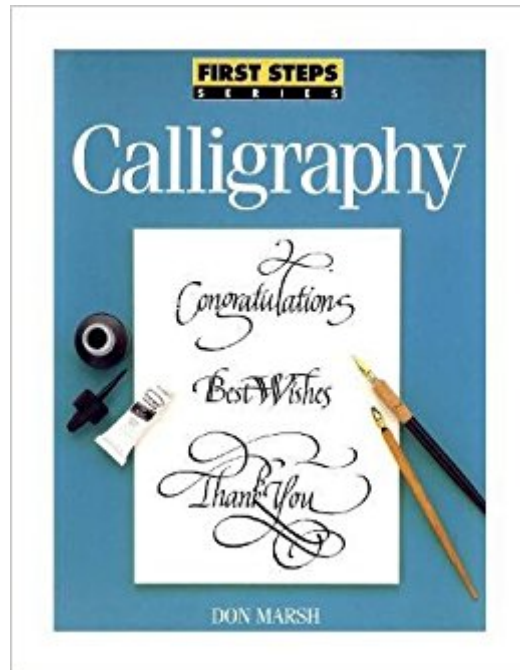

Part of North Light Books' "First Step" series, it is aimed at the "absolute beginner." Excellent for secondary school age and above, it features projects on greeting cards, invitations, and romantic verse. You want to know and start in the art of calligraphy? This is your book, simple, to the point, practical comments for the ignorant but interested person, just like me. Before reading this book you may have an idea of what calligraphy is, once you read this book you will have a very clear idea of it, the book will guide you and show you all the details of this art.
