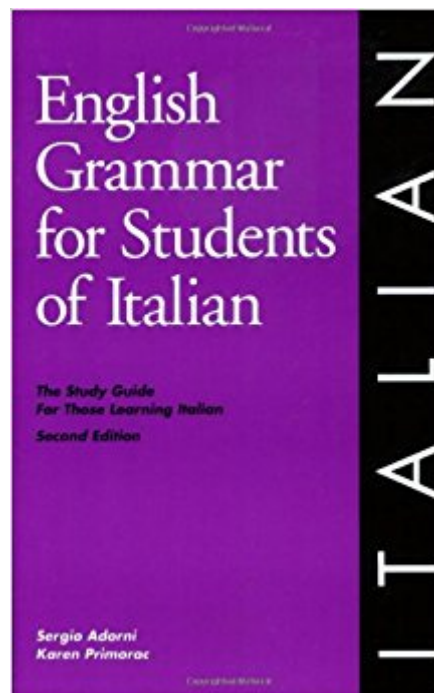

I love languages and have studied French and German. I have both books, the "English Grammar for Students of French (and German)". The biggest hurdle I had was not understanding English grammar well enough to understand how other languages applied their rules. Without understanding English grammar, learning a foreign can be tough. I learned more English grammar from this book than all the years of junior high, high school, and college combined. The simple method that the English Grammar for Students of (any language in the series) uses allows the student to make the breakthrough into the foreign language lessons. I've attended schools that are full immersion classes in French and German, and the teachers LOVED this book. Now that I'm moving on to Italian, English Grammar for Students of Italian will be joining me in class as well. This book should be a mandatory addition to any language class. Now, if the authors could just make one more in the series.....I'm also studying Polish and would love to get a better understanding of Polish grammar.

This grammar reference is not to be used by itself. It works best when used along with an Italian textbook or course. It is amazing when approaching the harder tenses, irregular verbs, gender differences, and plurality. It really compares side by side what the equivalent is in the English language with respect to grammar. It will not fail you. For example, there are things in every language, such as idioms, that are not easily translated or understood. This book touches on those subjects that are harder to most students, and effectively explains them in detail. I'm an advanced student of Italian, and I recommend it. :)
