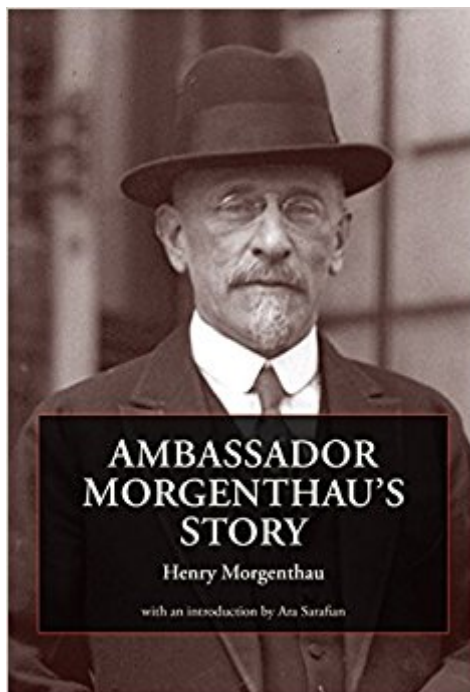

Henry Morgenthau was born Mannheim (Germany). He graduated from Columbia Law School and began professional life as a lawyer. He made a substantial fortune as a real estate developer - and was involved in philanthropy in New York City. He gained prominence in Woodrow Wilson's election campaign in 1912 and was rewarded with an ambassadorship to Ottoman Turkey in 1912. He remained active in politics and business after his return to the United States in 1916. His children and grandchildren include Henry Morgenthau, Jr. (Secretary of the Treasury under Franklin D. Roosevelt), Robert M. Morgenthau (District Attorney of Manhattan for 35 years), and the historian Barbara Tuchman.
