

Defining Moments: When Managers Must Choose Between Right And Right



Synopsis

"Defining moments," according to Badaracco, occur when managers face business problems that trigger difficult, deeply personal questions. In deciding how to act, managers reveal their inner values, test their commitment to those values, and ultimately shape their characters. Badaracco builds a framework for approaching these dilemmas around three cases of increasing complexity, reflecting the escalating responsibilities managers face as they advance in their careers. The first story presents a young man whose choice will affect him only as an individual; the second, a department head, whose decision will influence his organization; the third, a corporate executive, whose actions will have much larger, societal ramifications. To guide the decision-making process, Badaracco draws on the insights of four philosophers--Aristotle, Machiavelli, Nietzsche, and James--because they offer practical rather than theoretical advice. He thus bridges the gap between classroom philosophy and corporate pragmatism. The result is a flexible framework that managers can draw on to resolve issues of conflicting responsibility in practical ways.

Defining Moments is a thought provoking look at the moral and ethical element of decision making in the workplace. I was a student at the same MBA program where Badaracco teaches. I overlooked his class then, but 15 years later I came across this gem and loved it. Anyone can learn the basics - Finance, Marketing, etc... - but truly great leadership comes from being able to navigate situations like this book presents. As the head of my company, this book has been very valuable in giving me a framework to think through aspects of my job, and to help me better understand myself as well. This book was required reading for a business ethics class. Overall stories of the book were good examples of ethical dilemmas, but the content could have been delivered in a third of the time. The book often revisits topics from earlier chapters and keeps beating you over the head with some of the concepts. While I would not read the book again, it has opened my eyes to investigating some of the philosophers mentioned in the book.

I read this a few years after I had been in senior management and wished deeply that I had discovered it earlier. One of the great challenges facing new managers is decision making where the choices all involve some positive and negative aspects. There are also many organization pressures that force individuals to consider suboptimal paths to "be a team player." It's a slippery slope and one that is hard to navigate without a great deal of thought and a clarity of personal professional purpose. This is a small book that easily engages the reader in a fascinating path to understanding these core management issues. Management, especially senior management, starts to look like politics and turns into a soup of interests and circumstances that make the "right" decision hard to discern and possibly even harder to live with. Given the impact to size ratio and high quality of the writing I'd make this book a must-read in the category.

Badaracco's work is simple, yet sophisticated. He works through three character dilemmas and interweaves the applications of the great theorists in laymen terms to make this a book you cannot put down. It will unnerve you, there is a great deal of student introspection applied to the understanding of Badaracco. Enjoy! Ted
