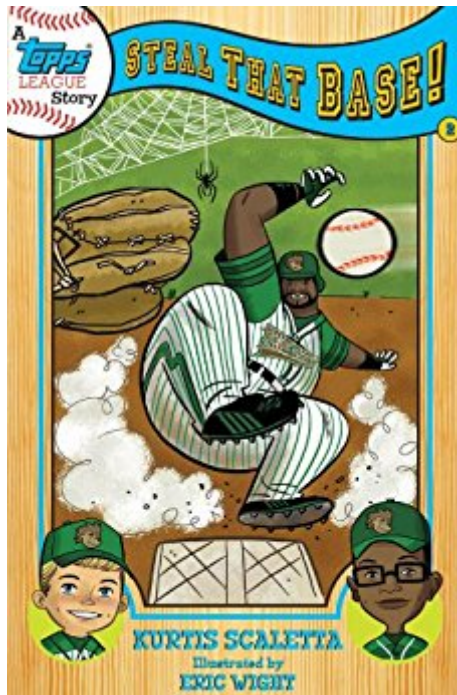

I've been reading with my grandson almost daily since he was four and this is one of the first books (he's seven now, second grade) that he has volunteered to read. He loves the 4 baseball cards that come with it and he remembers the players names even when I don't. We've read two of these so far. This one has a very good story line involving adults on the team as well as the two bat boys and a young girl who plays the part of a junior mascot (a porcupine named Spike) for this minor league team. It exemplifies good values like sharing, hard work, responsibility and friendship without being preachy. The main character's father is kind of a book nerd always reading about a variety of subjects and the other bat boy is not that interested in baseball but instead is fascinated with

animals. So there is lots of interesting detail about baseball and some real baseball history but plenty of other stuff too. The baseball players are great characters. As a former teacher, I have read a lot of children's books and these rate highly in interest and fun without any violence or tragedy needed.

What a great series of books! Our 9 & 6 year old boys love it. The author hits a HOME RUN!
