I've never found a writer with a more creative and captivating imagination. Another fantastic, welcome back to all of the quirky, friendly and caring folks in the growing town of Clear Creek and all of the characters, old and new, we've come to love! Each book is so well written, it seems you know all of the people and each one stands out in their own way without taking away from the captivating New story. We've already met a Duke and his new Duchess, their family and friends, as well as some delightful visits and assistance from Dallon, Shona, Lany and Angus from the TimeMasters series! I don't know of a series I've enjoyed more with so much going on but so well written, I'm never lost! There is such depth to each character and story! This story of Andel Berg, the new blacksmith, turns out to be so much more then he lets on. Then Madeline and her mother, Apalonia Van Zuyen, Countess of Dalrovia (Maddie is the princess and heir to the throne but has no idea. She's grown up totally in the dark about a hidden past), are brought to town by Shona and Dallon, who believe it's a good place for them to begin over. The Countess thinks it's a great place to hide out from those searching for the Princess, especially since she believes she's the only one who knows they're running and hiding from their past for 17 years. Is she really though? Not only does Maddie like Mr Berg, the unusual Blacksmith but the Countess seems to enjoy the company of another recent newcomer and father to the new Duchess (Duncan Cooks wife, Cozette) Andre Dupre'. The only problem is, though he's a wonderful, funny and kind gentleman, he's lived in the wilds so long and in his buckskins, with a beard and large fur hat that hides much of his features. The biggest problem is that he stinks-Lol; no one can figure the last time he's taken a bath! Apalonia enjoys his company so much but wishes she could see his features and he'd take a bath. Though all love and respect him, it's hard to tolerate being too close because of his stench! Soon after settling in Clear Creek, trouble arrives for many and Mr Berg saves Maddies life. Though well respected and loved, some begin to realize there is more to him than he's said. Is he really just a kind blacksmith as he seems or is he also hiding some deep, darker secrets? As he and Maddie begin to grow closer, we begin to learn much more about this very large, educated and well mannered young man. As usual, theirs is a unique journey to love with many surprises and twists along the way, while enjoying all of the quirks and involvement of this little but growing town of delightful characters. It's complete with the mysteries, gossip and all of the wonderfully funny matchmakers who just can't avoid getting involved! I'd recommend this book (as well as the whole series) to anyone who enjoys clean historical western romance with a bit of everything thrown in and then some! You won't be disappointed as you fall in love with all the characters in this small Oregon town and their zany mishaps.

I enjoyed all of the Prairie Brides series. Fairly clean romantic western book. Kit Morgan does a good job of just giving you little snips of the previous books, and just a taste of the next. You will grow to love the little town of Clear Creek and all it's crazy residents!I recommend ready the Prairie Brides series before the Prairie Groom series, but it is not necessary.

A royal family escapes from Norway to the Oregon Territory where the husband is killed. The wife and daughter come to live in Clear Creek although no one knows of their royalty. A servant of a cruel master in Norway sends him to the US to capture the daughter and return her to Norway for marriage so that the master can take over the throne. The author has a unique manner of developing characters and then uses them in unexpected ways to make the story interesting. The end of the book is not really too surprising, but many details were not expected as I read this book.
